Conclude your adventure in the alpine resort of Gudauri, surrounded by stunning mountain scenery and fresh highland air. This itinerary offers a perfect blend of culture, nature, adventure, and leisure—ideal for couples, families, and first-time visitors to Georgia.

ITINERARY

Day 1 | 19 March 2026 – Arrival in Tbilisi & City Tour

Upon arrival at Tbilisi International Airport, you will be warmly welcomed and transferred to the city. After breakfast at a local restaurant or your hotel, proceed to explore the highlights of Old Tbilisi. Visit the magnificent Holy Trinity Cathedral, followed by Metekhi Church overlooking the Mtkvari River. Enjoy a scenic cable car ride to Narikala Fortress for panoramic views of the city, then explore the Sulphur Baths district and stroll along the lively Shardeni Street. Continue to modern landmarks including the Bridge of Peace and Rike Park. After the tour, check in to your hotel and enjoy an overnight stay in Tbilisi.

Day 2 | 20 March 2026 – Kakheti Wine Region & Signaghi Tour

After breakfast, embark on a full-day excursion to the scenic Kakheti wine region. Visit the peaceful Bodbe Monastery, set amidst beautiful landscapes overlooking the Alazani Valley. Continue to Signaghi, the charming hilltop town known as the “City of Love,” famous for its cobbled streets, colorful balconies, and panoramic countryside views. Enjoy a wine tasting session at KTW Winery, experiencing the rich flavors and centuries-old wine-making traditions of Georgia. Return to Tbilisi in the evening for overnight stay.

Day 3 | 21 March 2026 – Mtskheta & Kazbegi Tour – Transfer to Gudauri

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and begin your journey toward Gudauri. En route, visit Mtskheta, Georgia’s ancient capital and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore the historic Jvari Monastery and Svetitskhoveli Cathedral, both of great religious and cultural importance. Continue towards Kazbegi, enjoying scenic mountain landscapes along the way. Experience a thrilling 4x4 ride to the iconic Gergeti Trinity Church, offering breathtaking views of the Caucasus Mountains. Stop at the Russian–Georgian Friendship Monument for memorable photo opportunities. Proceed to Gudauri, check in to your hotel, and relax overnight.

Day 4 | 22 March 2026 – Gudauri Exploration & Departure

After breakfast, enjoy the fresh mountain air of Gudauri. If time permits, experience a ride on the Gudauri Cable Car and take in stunning panoramic views of the surrounding peaks. Later, begin your scenic drive back toward Tbilisi, stopping at the impressive Ananuri Fortress and the picturesque Zhinvali Reservoir for photo opportunities. Continue to Tbilisi International Airport for your departure, concluding your unforgettable journey through Georgia..
