Overview

Journey onward to the storybook streets of Strasbourg before arriving in the "City of Light" — Paris. Here, marvel at Versailles, Montmartre, and iconic landmarks like the Eiffel Tower, with a serene Seine River cruise to complete the experience. A perfect blend of art, culture, cuisine, and scenic wonders, this trip captures Europe at its most magical.

Itinerary

Day 1 – Sunday: Welcome to Rome

Benvenuti in Roma! Upon arrival, our representative will meet you at the airport and transfer you to your hotel. Later in the day, you'll meet your guide for an introduction to the trip, with essential details also available on the information board at the hotel reception. In the evening, enjoy a welcome stroll along Via Cavour, a perfect first taste of the Eternal City. This lively street offers a wide variety of dining options—from authentic Italian to Indian, Chinese, and other international cuisines—setting the tone for your journey ahead.

Day 2 – Monday: Rome City tour - Optional Vatican Museum

Begin your morning with a captivating three-hour guided exploration of Rome, blending a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus journey. Highlights include the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum, the Imperial Forums, Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour concludes at Vatican City around 11:00 a.m., where your guide will offer an **optional visit** to the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel. In the evening, we'll take you to the charming district of Trastevere, renowned for its cozy trattorias and vibrant atmosphere, before returning to the hotel around 8:30 p.m.

Day 3 – Tuesday: Rome to Florence

This morning, we travel north through picturesque landscapes to reach Florence, the birthplace of the Renaissance. Upon arrival, we head to Piazzale Michelangelo for stunning panoramic views of the city. After some free time for lunch, enjoy a guided walking tour through the historic center, taking in iconic landmarks such as the Ponte Vecchio, the majestic Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. The afternoon is yours to explore Florence's art, boutiques, and cafés at your leisure. In the evening, the city offers countless dining choices to suit every taste.

Day 4 – Wednesday: Florence to Venice

Today's journey takes us across the scenic Apennines to Venice. Upon arrival, a boat will carry us across the Giudecca Canal to the heart of the city—St. Mark's Square. With a local guide, discover the rich history and architecture of Venice before visiting a Murano glass workshop to witness the art of glassmaking. Enjoy some free time to explore the charming canals and hidden squares before we head to our hotel in the Mestre district.

Day 5 – Thursday: Venice to Innsbruck to Zurich

We leave Italy and make our way into Austria, arriving in Innsbruck where you'll have time to explore the medieval old town and enjoy lunch. Our route then winds through the breathtaking Tyrolean Alps before crossing into Switzerland and arriving in Zurich for the night.

Day 6 – Friday: Zurich – Lucerne – Zurich

Experience the postcard-perfect scenery of Switzerland as we head into the Interlaken region. Our first stop is Grindelwald, where we take a cable car up the mountain for a scenic walk to a suspended bridge, offering incredible glacier views. Lunch is included on the mountain before descending to the valley. In the afternoon, visit Lucerne, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, with time to stroll along its lakeside promenades and historic streets before returning to Zurich. **Optional upgrade:** take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis for unforgettable alpine views.

Day 7 – Saturday: Zurich to Strasbourg to Paris

We travel from Zurich to the French region of Alsace, visiting its charming capital, Strasbourg. This city beautifully blends French and German influences and offers a delightful old town to explore. After lunch, continue to Paris, arriving in the evening.

Day 8 – Sunday: Versailles & Paris Highlights

This morning, explore the grandeur of the Palace of Versailles (admission not included), famed for its opulent halls and spectacular gardens. Returning to Paris, discover Montmartre, the bohemian quarter known for its artists and vibrant atmosphere. A panoramic city tour follows, showcasing Paris's grand avenues, monuments, and romantic charm. Optional evening variety show available.

Day 9 – Monday: Eiffel Tower & Seine River

Our day begins with a visit to the Eiffel Tower, where tickets to the second level are included for spectacular views. Then, enjoy a scenic Seine River cruise lasting about 75 minutes. The rest of the afternoon is free for shopping, sightseeing, or café hopping at your leisure (return transfer not included). Note: Eiffel Tower timings may be adjusted depending on crowd conditions.

Day 10 – Tuesday: Farewell to Paris

After breakfast, your unforgettable journey through Italy, Switzerland, and France comes to an end. Depart with cherished memories and stories to last a lifetime.
