Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Copenhagen – The Heart of Denmark

Welcome to Copenhagen, the vibrant capital of Denmark! Upon arrival at Copenhagen Airport, you will be greeted by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Take the afternoon to relax after your journey or begin exploring the city at your own pace. Copenhagen is known for its rich history, contemporary architecture, and world-class culinary scene. Day 2: Exploring Copenhagen – A City of Fairytales

Visit one of the city’s world-class museums, enjoy shopping along Strøget street, or relax in a cozy café.

Day 3: Journey from Copenhagen to Stockholm – Crossing into Sweden

Departing from Copenhagen, we head north towards Elsinore (Helsingør), a charming coastal town home to Kronborg Castle, famously known as Hamlet’s Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. From Elsinore, take a short 20-minute ferry ride across the Öresund Strait to Sweden. Enjoy the scenic landscapes as we journey through rolling countryside, picturesque lakes, and dense forests. Our first stop in Sweden is Jönköping, a charming town located on the shores of Lake Vättern, one of the largest lakes in Sweden. Take time to enjoy lunch and explore its beautiful lakeside setting. Continue to Vadstena, a picturesque medieval town renowned for its 14th century castle and historic monastery. Walk through its narrow cobbled streets, lined with traditional wooden houses, and take in the serene lakeside views. By evening, we arrive in Stockholm, the capital of Sweden. Known as the "Venice of the North," Stockholm is built across 14 islands, connected by elegant bridges and ferries.

- ◆ Overnight stay in Stockholm.

Day 4: Discovering Stockholm – Sweden’s Stunning Capital

Begin your day with a panoramic tour of Stockholm, a city that seamlessly blends medieval charm with modern sophistication. Your guided tour will take you through: Gamla Stan (Old Town) – One of the best-preserved medieval districts in Europe, filled with charming alleyways, historic buildings, and lively squares. The Royal Palace – Home to the Swedish royal family, where you can witness the Changing of the Guard. Stortorget Square & the Nobel Prize Museum – Learn about the history of the prestigious Nobel Prize and admire the surrounding historic buildings. Fjällgatan Viewpoint – Enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of Stockholm and its archipelago. After the tour,

you will have free time to explore at your own pace. You may choose to visit the famous Vasa Museum, which houses a perfectly preserved 17th-century warship, or take a scenic boat ride through the archipelago.

Day 5: Free Day in Stockholm & Overnight Cruise to Finland

Spend the day exploring Stockholm at your leisure. You can visit more museums, enjoy Swedish cuisine, or explore its stylish shopping districts. In the evening, board a modern overnight ferry bound for Finland. Experience the excitement of a luxurious Baltic Sea cruise, with onboard restaurants, entertainment, and shopping. Relax in your private en-suite cabin as you sail through the scenic waters.

Day 6: Turku – Naantali – Helsinki: Exploring Finland’s West Coast

As the ferry arrives in Turku, Finland’s oldest city, head to the deck to witness the stunning views of the Åland Islands, a breathtaking archipelago of over 6,500 forested islands. Explore Turku, a city with a rich Swedish heritage and historic riverside architecture. Continue to Naantali, a charming seaside town known for its wooden houses and picturesque harbor. Arriving in Helsinki by midday, you will have the afternoon free to explore the city’s unique blend of Russian, Nordic, and Art Nouveau influences.

Day 7: Helsinki to Tallinn – Crossing the Gulf of Finland

In the afternoon, board a 2.5-hour ferry across the Gulf of Finland to Estonia. Enjoy panoramic views of Helsinki’s archipelago as you sail towards Tallinn. By evening, arrive in Tallinn, Estonia’s fairytale-like capital.

Alexander Nevsky Cathedral – A grand Russian Orthodox church with stunning onion domes. Spend the afternoon at leisure, exploring the city’s many museums, craft shops, and charming cafés.
