Overview

This 09-day journey through the Baltic capitals and Poland offers a wonderful blend of history, culture and scenic landscapes. Begin in Tallinn, where medieval streets, ancient walls and charming

old-town squares create a timeless atmosphere. Continue through Latvia to discover the coastal town of Pärnu, the historic beauty of Turaida Castle and the vibrant capital of Riga, known for its elegant Art Nouveau architecture. Travel onwards to Lithuania to visit the magnificent Rundāle Palace, the spiritual Hill of Crosses, the lakeside Trakai Island Castle and the Baroque charm of Vilnius. The journey concludes in Warsaw, where beautifully restored old-town streets, historic landmarks and vibrant city life create the perfect finale. This itinerary combines medieval heritage, cultural treasures, scenic countryside and memorable city experiences across four fascinating countries.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Tallinn

Welcome to Tallinn, the charming capital of Estonia. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is free to relax after your journey or begin exploring the city at your own pace. Wander through the nearby streets, enjoy the atmosphere of the medieval old town, or unwind at one of the local cafés. In the afternoon, you will receive detailed information about your tour either directly from your guide or via the information board at the hotel reception. Overnight stay in Tallinn.

Day 2: Tallinn City Tour

After breakfast, enjoy a guided panoramic tour of Tallinn, one of the best-preserved medieval cities in Europe and a UNESCO-listed treasure. Explore its historic old town with beautifully preserved city walls, medieval towers, churches, cobbled lanes and lively squares. Discover the city's unique atmosphere where history blends with vibrant modern culture. Admire the architectural heritage, charming merchant houses and panoramic viewpoints overlooking the red rooftops of the old city. The afternoon is free for independent exploration, shopping for local handicrafts, or relaxing in one of Tallinn's many cafés and restaurants. Overnight stay in Tallinn.

Day 3: Tallinn – Pärnu – Turaida – Sigulda – Salaspils – Riga

This morning depart from Tallinn and travel south through scenic forests and open countryside. Your first stop will be Pärnu, a popular seaside resort known for its relaxed atmosphere and coastal charm. Continue onward into Latvia, where an included lunch will be served before visiting the impressive Turaida Castle. Set within a beautiful parkland, the castle offers panoramic views, sculptures and a fascinating insight into medieval Baltic history. Later, enjoy time in the picturesque town of Sigulda, surrounded by green valleys and forests. Before arriving in Riga, stop at the moving Salaspils Memorial, built in memory of victims of the former Nazi concentration camp. Continue to Riga, arriving in the evening for overnight stay.

Day 4: Riga City Tour

After breakfast, enjoy a panoramic guided tour of Riga, the largest and most vibrant city in the Baltic region. The city is renowned for its remarkable Art Nouveau architecture, elegant boulevards and atmospheric medieval old town. During the tour, discover its historic centre, lively squares, churches and buildings that reflect both Latvian tradition and traces of the Soviet era. The afternoon is free for you to explore further at your own pace—perhaps visit local markets, museums, cafés or stroll through the charming streets of the old city. Overnight stay in Riga.



Day 5: Riga – Rundale – Hill of Crosses – Trakai – Vilnius

Depart Riga this morning and continue towards Lithuania. En route, visit the magnificent Rundāle Palace, one of the finest examples of Baroque architecture in the Baltics, often compared to the imperial palaces of Europe. Continue to the remarkable Hill of Crosses, a symbolic pilgrimage site covered with thousands of crosses placed by visitors over generations. An included lunch will be served during the journey. Later, visit the beautiful Trakai Island Castle, dramatically situated on an island in the middle of a lake. Surrounded by tranquil scenery, it is one of Lithuania's most iconic landmarks. Continue to Vilnius for overnight stay.

Day 6: Vilnius City Tour

After breakfast, discover the elegance of Vilnius, a city built across seven hills and often compared to Rome. Your panoramic city tour introduces you to the historic old town, one of the largest preserved medieval centres in Eastern Europe. Explore Baroque churches, ancient walls, narrow streets, lively squares and beautiful architecture that reflects centuries of history and cultural influence. You will also see bustling commercial streets and traditional buildings that make the city unique. The afternoon is free to enjoy at leisure—perfect for exploring hidden courtyards, boutiques or local cafés. Overnight stay in Vilnius.

Day 7: Vilnius – Grutas Park – Augustów – Warsaw

This morning depart Vilnius and continue towards Poland. Your first stop is Grūtas Park, often referred to as Stalin's World, where Soviet-era statues and monuments are displayed in an open-air museum. Continue to the charming lakeside town of Augustów, known for its canals, lakes and relaxed atmosphere. Enjoy lunch before continuing south through the Polish countryside. Arrive in Warsaw by evening and check in to your hotel for overnight stay.

Day 8: Warsaw City Tour

Today explore Warsaw, the dynamic capital of Poland, accompanied by a local guide. Discover a city that beautifully blends modern urban life with carefully restored historic architecture. Stroll through the charming old town, rebuilt after World War II and now recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit the historic squares, cobbled streets and admire the Royal Castle, Warsaw. See the monumental Palace of Culture and Science, a famous symbol of the city. Learn about Warsaw's wartime history, including the former Jewish ghetto area, before continuing to the beautiful Łazienki Park, home to the celebrated Chopin Monument. The afternoon is free for independent sightseeing, shopping or visiting museums such as the Warsaw Rising Museum. Overnight stay in Warsaw.

Day 9: Departure from Warsaw

After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Depending on your onward travel arrangements, you may have some free time before departure. Your memorable journey through the Baltic capitals and Poland comes to an end today, taking with you wonderful memories of medieval towns, historic landmarks and beautiful landscapes.
